<p>1</p>	<p>Introduction to the course: <i>Students will be able to:</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Get to know each other and understand what to expect from the course curriculum ● Understand their overall task for the course <p>Discover the World of Law <i>Students will be able to:</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Learn about the purpose of law, including the differences between public and private law ● Explore ideas at the intersection of Law & Philosophy
<p>2</p>	<p>Explore the Legal System <i>Students will be able to:</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Understand the difference between (and the hierarchy of) criminal and civil courts
<p>3</p>	<p>Understanding Criminal Law <i>Students will be able to:</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Reflect on some of the ethics involved in working as a criminal defendant ● Explore what it means to be "guilty beyond reasonable doubt."
<p>4</p>	<p>Debate Human Rights <i>Students will be able to:</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Explore whether human rights are universal and learn the role of international organisations, such as Amnesty International
<p>5</p>	<p>Big Business and the Law <i>Students will be able to:</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Explore what happens if a contract is breached ● Explore different areas of corporate law, ● Learn how businesses rely on contracts, property and intellectual property law
<p>6</p>	<p>Analyse International Law <i>Students will be able to:</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Find out how international bodies like the International Criminal Court resolve famous cases ● Explore the role of the UN
<p>7</p>	<p>The History of Law <i>Students will be able to:</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Go back in time and see how law has advanced from the ancient period (Egyptians and Babylonians) to eastern traditions (China, India, Islamic world) and the West
<p>8</p>	<p>The Law in Practice and as a career <i>Students will be able to:</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Explore the paths that lawyers take (barristers and solicitors) ● Explore the role of judges, courts and parliaments
